Accepting Christ as Savior

KNOWING THAT YOUR SINS ARE FORGIVEN AND YOU ARE READY FOR HEAVEN IS AS SIMPLE AS FOLLOWING THESE STEPS:

A

ADMIT YOU HAVE SINNED

“If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us.”
1 John 1:8

Admit you need God to forgive you of your sins, attitudes and actions that don't meet His standard. Admit you need His help to show you His purpose for your life.

B

BELIEVE IN THE SAVIOR, JESUS CHRIST

“For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him will not perish but have everlasting life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him.”
John 3:16 & 17

Believe that Jesus died for your sins. Believe that Jesus rose from the dead.

C

CONFESS AND TURN AWAY FROM YOUR SIN

“If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”
1 John 1:9

“If you confess with your mouth Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.”
Romans 10:9-10

Confess that Jesus is Lord of your life.
